Youth

The Collectif supports young people who were placed in youth protection by giving them a voice and opportunities to work together.

It provides prevention services, support, education and advocacy. Its continuum of action is organized around three programs:

Entrepairs: Create and maintain a self-help community run by and for young people who are or were under youth protection in order to foster a sense of belonging and fight isolation by promoting mutual support.

• Repairs: Support projects by young people designed to keep kids in school and prevent them from ending up on the street. Provide individual and group support during the transition to adulthood through themed activities and personalized guidance.

• Coopairs: Improve social policies and practices to meet the needs and rights of young people in youth protection. Promote the active participation of the young people concerned and work with partners including government departments and agencies.

Cooking workshops for elderly women in the Lower St. Lawrence region **Seniors** 

The cooking workshops empower elderly women by helping them cook healthy meals despite financial difficulties. They break down isolation and give participants the skills they need to prepare balanced, economical meals.

Intergenerational Climate Resilience project

Mandoul (RCIM)

Generations of women growers join forces.

The RCIM project uses an innovative approach to strengthen green entrepreneurship by women and promote diversified women's leadership. Encouraging women's participation in inclusive dialogue forums puts them on the path to become agents of change.

The project also aims to value traditional knowledge, help women adopt new farming techniques, and strengthen intergenerational social cohesion.

This combination of approaches will strengthen the resilience of women farmers in the face of climate change.

The project will reach 960 people directly (80% women, 43% youngpeople and 9% seniors) in 12 communities in Mandoul province and benefit 7,700 people indirectly.

PACIT Women's rights, maternal and child health

Haïti

Mission Inclusion, formerly known as L'ŒUVRE LÉGER, has been supporting maternal and child health in Haiti since 1986. Through projects such as PROSAMI, we have rebuilt medical facilities, provided emergency obstetric and neonatal services, and opened a modern operating room, putting into action our strong commitment to health and hope for the future of Haitian women.



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
